**Street Briefings:** Meet your Neighbourhood Policing Team and discuss any local concerns you are experiencing in your area. Our next Street Briefings are:

**Ward Panel:** This is when members of the community and your local Policing Team meet to discuss specific problems within the area. These concerns then become area priorities for your local Officers to try and address. The date of the next Ward Panel meeting will be confirmed in due course.

#### PRIORITIES FOR POUND HILL:

Set at the Pound Hill/Maidenbower/Worth Ward Panel meeting on 27 May 2010.

**Priority 1 - Ongoing problems with speeding vehicles**

**What you said:** Speeding vehicles on Worth Road and Worth Park Avenue. Other areas of Pound Hill also affected by speeding vehicles but these need to be risk assessed by the Road Policing Unit prior to speed operations being able to be carried out.

**What we are doing:** Community Speed Watch operations have now commenced. The Neighbourhood Policing Team is also conducting speed operations.

**What has happened:** Speed operations were carried out in Pound Hill by the Neighbourhood Policing Team on 20/05/10. On 21/05/10, speed operations were carried out by members of the Community Speed Watch.

**Priority 2: Parking near Pound Hill Infant & Junior School and Milton Mount School.**

**What you said:** Vehicles being parked illegally near schools during drop-off and pick up times.

**What we are doing:** School patrols are being carried out.

**What has happened:** Letters to residents near schools have been reminded of Operation Crackdown in order to report offending vehicles.

**Priority 3: Cyclist on footpaths**

**What you said:** Cyclists are using footpaths

**What we are doing:** Cyclists are stopped and words of advice given.
